

Unconventional Gas Outlook 2025

A South Australian Focus

Core Energy Group is currently leading a study into the Australian outlook for Unconventional Gas through to 2025 to determine its potential to meet future demand for gas and how it sits in a competitive sense relative to conventional supply sources. The study extends across shale and tight gas, coal mine methane, coal seam gas and underground coal gasification. Several of these sources of potential supply are being pursued actively in South Australia with a view to delivering against the States key energy objectives of reliability, cost effectiveness and environmental sustainability, while offering the potential for significant economic activity and State royalties.

As a parallel initiative, Core is now inviting clients to attend a seminar "Unconventional Gas Outlook 2025: A South Australian Focus" which provides a high level perspective of the challenge and potential supply pathways for the State and Australia more broadly. The session does not address technical, financial and economic details. Such details will only be available to study participants.

- SA's energy future
- The opportunity for Unconventional Gas in South Australia
- Key technical challenges
- Competitive dynamics
- Case Studies - Beach Energy, Linc Energy, Stuart Petroleum.
